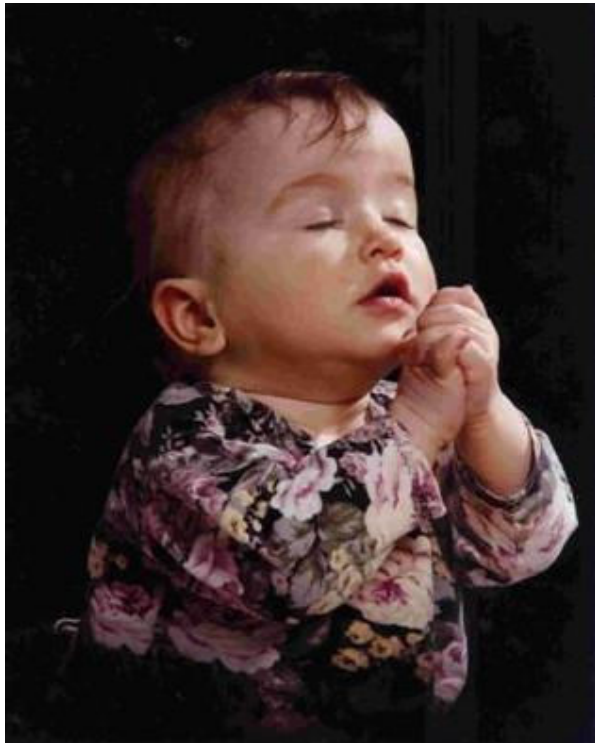

PREFACE

For many people, prayer is a difficult or repetitive act, since they failed to truly understand what this means. There is no secret when we understand the difference between praying and read something that's written by someone (to recite a prayer).

This kind of thing is simply to repeat a prayer or supplication; however, without putting our being entirely in what we are doing. In other words, without the soul can express itself freely before God as it wants. When we only recite a prayer written by someone, there is a certain formality in our communication, because we only speak with the lips while the heart stays without expressing the distorted and sick emotions that need of healing. It is there that the Lord needs to touch, so that we feel whole again and may remove what is bringing us inner conflict.

The true prayer goes further: it leads us to a meditation on the Word of God, putting our thoughts and feelings in confrontation with it and thus, showing us where we need to change to get what we are seeking. Prayer creates intimacy with the Lord, and makes Him, increasingly, a partaker in our lives.

Then, prayer allows us the free expression of our heart at that moment. The words written before us are nothing but guides so that our mouth can translate our feelings, and so that our mind can bring up our deepest thoughts. Prayer opens the doors of our hearts to God's throne.

This book was inspired by a simple prayer that I wrote one day when I was feeling very sad and in need of answers from the Lord. My heart opened to Him asking for what I wanted most, while His healing reached inside me, bringing me

certainty that I was being heard. It is the first prayer I put in this book.

I put in this work some biblical passages that will direct you in your prayer, while the Spirit of God opens the doors of your heart and mind to develop your own way to communicate with Him. It is like talking to a friend in whom we trust, unreservedly, and with the conviction that we will be helped.

I hope you understand the simplicity of God and start to take on you position as a child and friend of the Lord. I'm sure that you will discover the true source that feeds you.

You came to earth and performed many healings and deliverances, showing that neither sin nor sickness, nor the things in the world or of the darkness have power over you. You freed many children so that they could walk freely, without the chains of paralysis. Thus, Lord, I want to be freed from all that has held me to indecision and sin, preventing me from knowing your will for me. Without the touch of your hands I can not feel myself a helpful person and accomplished as I want to be. Without the liberating power of your word, I will not be able to bear witness to you. (Inspired by Matt. 11: 7-19

– Jesus bears witness to John the Baptist)

Sovereign Lord and God! I know that today you come to me with a new opportunity to correct me from my sins, especially in relation to the spiritual area. I recognize in me the pride, rebellion, criticism, omission, prejudice and the lack of courage to assume your truth, because so far I resisted it and practiced what was disagreeable to your eyes. I know you don't take pleasure in rebellion or idolatry. When we insist with you we can not go very far. Teach me the truth of your word and deliver me from all lying knowledge that stained my clothes with the color of sin and clouded my mind to your purpose. I give my soul in your hands because your judgment is fair and impartial, but I make the decision to throw down my old life and start to rebuild it upon other foundations. Jesus, I can not deny your name before men anymore, for this would make you deny me also before the Father and His angels, as it's written in your word. Accept me as a child and be my Father. Amen.

(Inspired by Lk. 19: 1-9 – Zacchaeus the tax collector)

Lord, other values besides it have occupied your place in my heart, but I decide to free myself from all this, surrendering my life to you and recognizing that all threats and lies I've heard until today moved me away from your presence and almost stole my salvation. That is why, after so much suffering that I have gone through, I surrender today to your sovereignty and your mercy, knowing that I will not be forsaken in any area of my life and that you'll take the government and the control over all of them. (Inspired by Matt. 5: 43-48 – the love of neighbor)

Take my heart in your hands and teach me to obey you in relation to the greatest commandment which is love. I have too much difficulty, Lord, to forgive and to love. I know that you alone are able to free me from these chains and to give me the freedom of your Spirit. Just this way I can walk with my head held high among my brothers. Heal my wounds and pains, and give me strength to overcome the temptations and not to repeat the same mistakes of the past. I know I can not put the guilt of my actions on others anymore, because today you give me back the free will, which places on my hands the responsibility to decide my path and the authority to overcome evil. Help me to be meek and gentle on your hands, so that I can conquer a kingdom much bigger than I thought to have until today. I want to be like you. I know I can do nothing without you, because in my flesh there is no good, but by the power of your Spirit I'll be able to win. Receive my prayer and my surrender and take on your lordship over me. Amen.

EPILOGUE

I hope that the Lord has touched your heart with healing and you have discovered in prayer a powerful weapon to win every battle, and a flat path to get to the altar. Now it's the practice that will improve you in this very sure way of communicating with God.

Jesus set us the example, as a man, going up the mount every night to talk to the Father. Through this dialogue, He received strength to work the next day and fulfill His mission.

He taught us a secret: "And whenever you pray, do not be like the hypocrites; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and at the street corners, so that they may be seen by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward. But whenever you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you. When you are praying, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do; for they think that they will be heard because of their many words. Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him" (Matt. 6: 5-8).

He tells us that when we pray, we should 'go into our room', that is, to enter into the silence of our spirit and of our soul and there, in awe, talk to the Father. Even if He knows what we need, He wants hear us, because prayer, doesn't really matter for God if we do with the mouth open or closed. However, it is important to us because when we verbalize what we think or feel, we know ourselves. This returns us the authority over our own lives. And what we ask, we can be certain that we will receive:

- Mk. 11: 24: "So I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours."

- Jn. 14: 13-14: "I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If in my name you ask me for anything, I will do it."

- Jn. 15: 16: "You did not choose me but I chose you. And I appointed you to go and bear fruit, fruit that will last, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask him in my name."

- 1 Jn. 5: 14-15: "And this is the boldness we have in him, that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us in whatever we ask, we know that we have obtained the requests made of him."

That's why we pray to the Father in the name of Jesus. It is by the name of His Son that the Father gives us what we ask.

May the Lord bless you and grant your wishes in the name of Jesus.
